# Preparing Myself to Hear God

## **By getting right with God**

“But if we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous, forgiving us our sins and cleansing us from all unrighteousness.” —1 John 1:9

(2 Corinthians 6:16;7:1; Hebrews 10:22; 12:14)

## **By surrendering my will to Him.**

“We know that God doesn’t listen to sinners, but if anyone is devout and does his will, God listens to him.” —John 9:31

“Teach me to do what pleases you, for you are my God. May your kind presence lead me into a level land.” —Psalms 143:10

(Proverbs 16:3; 23:26; Romans 12:1; 1 John 3:21-22)

## **By humbling myself before Him.**

“He has told you, O man, what is good, and what the Lord really wants from you: He wants you to carry out justice, to love faithfulness, and to live obediently before your God.” —Micah 6:8

“The reward for humility and fearing the Lord is riches and honor and life.” — Proverbs 22:4

(Proverbs 16:5; 29:23; Philippians 2:5-8)

## **By renewing my mind with His truth.**

“Do not be conformed to this present world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may test and approve what is the will of God - what is good and well-pleasing and perfect.” —Romans 12:2

(Philippians 4:8)

## **By having a mindset of faith, trust and expectancy toward God.**

“For we live by faith, not by sight.” —2 Corinthians 5:7

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own understanding. Acknowledge him in all your ways, and he will make your paths straight.” — Proverbs 3:5-6

(Romans 14:23; Hebrews 10:23,36,38; 11:6)

## **By being patient and willing to wait on God.**
